





Inward Migrants


- Mostly young (90%+ under 45).
- Collapse in numbers coming from Accession States.
- Roughly 50/50 gender ratio.

Outward Migrants


- Mostly young (90%+ under 45).
- Those leaving from Accession States peaked in 2009.
- Over half of those leaving now are Irish.
- 52-60% male.






Participation Rate

Conclusions

- We have large pools of underutilised labour resources
